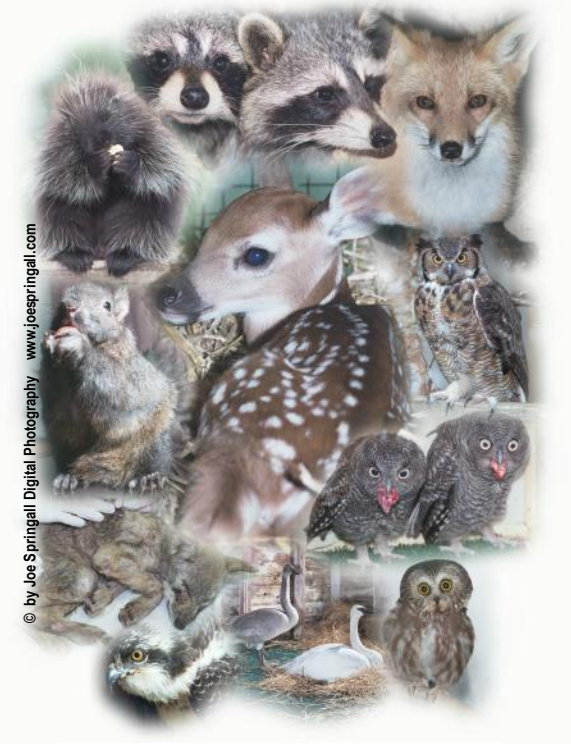

#### A Brief History of OWREN

OWREN (The Ontario Wildlife Rehabilitation and Education Network) was founded in 1990 to support and inform professional wildlife rehabilitators in the province of Ontario. OWREN provides an educational information network, produces and distributes educational materials and training opportunities for wildlife rehabilitators, related professionals and members of the public interested in wildlife rehabilitation.

OWREN maintains its work as a professional educational support network for provincial wildlife custodians and rehabilitation volunteers, or foster care givers, acts as an educational liaison for members and others in the province and internationally.

OWREN offers educational opportunities in Ontario through wildlife rehabilitation skills courses. Our Basic Skills Course is accepted as the equivalent to the Ministry of Natural Resources OWRE Exam; a first step in obtaining a wildlife custodial authorization in Ontario for those who successfully complete the components of the course. OWREN also hosts educational conferences, advanced skills workshops and seminars for rehabilitators, related professionals and members of the public. *We invite you to join us!*

Wildlife rehabilitation is the practice of skilled, knowledgeable and dedicated care provided by qualified persons for injured, orphaned, diseased or displaced wildlife. Rehabilitators have one ultimate goal; to return wildlife to their native habitat, in optimum health.
